vs 5+16 "That Day"

- There is a day coming
- "The Day of the Lord" - the most anticipated event in the Bible, the most preached about... Every prophet names it... Jesus warns us... John the Baptist preaches about... And in NT Paul is confirming that this DAY is still coming...

vs 16 "by Jesus Christ..."

As surely that Judgment will come one day  
Redemption has already come

- Just as surely the Day of Lord will come

and I wouldn't have to endure the wrath to come
