

Romans 3:1-8

- This passage has been a difficult passage for me
- I don't think I've ever heard someone preach about these 8 verses. And now I know why?
- I believe if we stick with it, God will bless
- The blessings of the Holy Bible are there for us
- But that doesn't mean it's a 3-course meal set on the table...
- Sometimes you gotta work for it... like a Brazil nut or a hazel nut... Sure the nut is good and delicious, but no-one's gonna just give it to you... you gotta have some help like a hammer or a nutcracker, and you gotta work at it...
- Romans 3:1-8 has been like that for me
- There's a lot of ~~big~~ nuggets & jewels here in this passage... You can smell them & sense, but to get them out is rather difficult.
- But God has been good and let me see a few things I'd like to share...
- The key to opening up these verses for me was in Verse 5. So I want to start there to explain what's going on in that verse...

Read vs 5:

But then adds a little phrase in there between parentheses, 5 words \rightarrow (I speak as a man)
I'm presenting a hypothetical situation here.

I'm asking a thought-provoking question, but I'm speaking as a man...

- Well, everybody knows that Paul is a man
- not a woman... So he's not identifying his gender...

- Paul is human and everybody knows that, he's not an alien, or a Vulcan, or Klingon, he's not an angel or a devil. He's a man
So he's not identifying his species -
- Paul is, as everyone knows, is not a child
"To all that he in Rome, beloved, called to be saints."
He's writing to people he knows, or knew him - They know that Paul is no child. He's a man, a grown man.

(I speak as a man) What's he talking about?

You see, his ~~phrase~~ is a timer, if you can tune this dial right, it will all make sense - The message come through with clarity -

Well, thank God for context... I was gonna tell you, "This is what I think he means..."
But Paul has given us context to draw from -
Look at verse 4.

"God forbid, yea, let God be true, but every man a liar...

- And whoop, there it is... That's what Paul is talking about... "I speak as a man"
- The question I present to you is one that would come from the mouth of monk and mouth of man is full of lies -
- This question or statement is typical of what a mom would say, ~~and every~~ what most every mom would say, ~~but~~ every man is a liar -

Tetwo

- So if $A > B \neq B = C$ Then $A \neq C$

- So instead of saying (I speak as a man)
to better understand the passage, I find it profitable
to read it as such (I speak as a liar)
- So, a little lesson that I learned here:
 - You don't necessarily have to say something to
be a liar.
 - All you gotta do is ask.
 - We often think lying is telling something that
is false, well not true. You can lie by
asking something false...
 - Man is not a liar because he lies. He lies
because he's a liar.
 - You start thinking about this lying begins
with questions. Why? Because when you
consider lying, you're questioning the truth
which - Something to think about!

- (I speak as a man) I speak as a liar,
I speak as a fool. This is the question
- Of a fool
- ~~But if you comment the Book of God what
should we say? Is it God or who take man's name?~~
- This is a demonstration of foolish reasoning
- So let's go back... and reason with Paul

- Remember, we're talking about Paul, Jesus
- He's around the Heretics & Gnostics
- He's around the Hypocrites & Religious
- And now his son Helius or Andrew

VS2 he says, "Unto them were committed
the Oracles of God."

- What are the oracles of God?

- We always thought Psalm 119 was the perfect
demonstration of the oracles of God.

- We can read the 1st few verses to get an understanding.
Read Psalm 119:1-7, 9

v1 - The Law of the Lord vs 5 Thy statutes

v2 - His testimonies vs 6 Thy commandments

v3 - His ways vs 7 Righteous judgments

v4 - Thy precepts vs Thy Word

This Bible IS the oracles of God.

David said. ¹⁷The Law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul.

The testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.

The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart.

The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes.

The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring for ever.

The judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.

More to be desired are they than gold, yea,

than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and
the honeycomb. Moreover,

By them is thy servant warned, and in keeping
of them there is great reward.

Song: Why should I gain from his reward
I do not have an answer.

But thus I know with all my heart -

His blood has paid my ransom.

- "What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit is there in circumcision -
MUCH EVER WAY; CHIEFLY, because
unto THEM were committed the oracles of
God.
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- Not given - but committed.

vs 3. This is where the foolish questions begin
(READ)

- All the promise that God has given the Jews..
- He's promised them Deliverance, Salvation, Love.
- Pardon & Mercy, --
- What happens if someone doesn't believe? ???
- If what the bible says of God is true, what happens if I don't believe it, does that mean it's not true?
- In other words, what God is God's faithfulness to someone that doesn't believe it? It must not be any good is (the implication)
- You mean, this is as silly a question as If a tree falls in the forest, and nobody hears it, does it make any noise?
- Of course it does, you moron. Only a fool or an imbecile would ask such a question.

Paul answers the question:

Read vs 4

Verse 4 Explanation... (found true) ...you'll see
· Psalm 51 David & Bathsheba

(RBAZ)
verse 5. Okay then fine. Then if that is so, why am I being judged

- This is so smart-a-lic a question, that Paul had to put in ()
- Paul was saying, "I don't want to....."
- This is a hypothetical question from a fool.
- ~~What does God care about?~~
- If the main objective is to Glory God and if God gets the Glory even in my sin, then why do I get judged when God still gets the glory?

Look at Vess 7 | Read it | Repeat it | The question

I want you to see Core of the question in (Verse 5)

- = Is God unrighteous? (Repeat a few times)
- = The Fool question the righteousness of God

- And it's to this that Paul answers.

Q Is God unrighteous? GOD FORBID

- Paul OH NO! That it would come to that... God FORBID "Has not God judge the world?"

- So we see Paul's ^{heart} mind + where our ^{heart} minds oughta be

This question "Is God in righteous?" strikes at the very foundation of Paul's ~~Feeling~~ mind of the workings of Paul's heart & mind.

2 vs 3 Read

vs 12 & 16

In Paul's heart & mind, There no doubt, nor fleshly other possibility but that

#1 There will be judgment →

#2 God will be the Judge ...

In order for God to be the Ultimate Judge
He must be Utterly Righteous.

Luke 18:73

- To say that God in UNrighteous would turn the whole world upside down.
- It would put a mere man on the cross.
- It would burn the law in a crisp.
- If God is not righteous, then nothing is or ever will be.
- If God is not just & righteous then we have ^{absolutely} nothing
- > How can you dare suggest, "Is God unrighteous?"

God FORBID

Read vs 6

- Why can I judged as a sinner?
- My Damnation isn't just... Is what your saying
- My Damnation is not right
- God is wrong to condemn me
- Paul says "No, your damnation is just."
- It's not just, it's not right, it's wrong.
- God has made an error
- This gets us stuck dat in the Middle of Math 6:21-23
 - + Revelation 20
- White throne judgment, You'll have argue with God saying, "My damnation isn't just!"
- READ (Mark 6:22)
- Lord you got it wrong. list →
- I appeal, I want to file an appeal to another judge or to a higher court because you God have got it all wrong, wrong, wrong...
- What picture of the opposite of what it takes to be saved...

According to my terms, I should go in...
Terms testing My damnation isn't just!

Not man's life fit

- ✓ ↗ - It's not our terms, but God's terms,
- God has sent the invoice, for the wages of sin is death
- And God has set the terms... It's Not Net 30: 45: 60
- It's Net Jesus... Jesus paid it All
- But the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our LORD
- GOD posted the terms on the cross of Galvany
- The Bills been payed... The Law has been fulfilled... Jesus paid it all
